

This CPC Subcommittee Pre-conference Subcommittee Report covers three areas; a response to Delegate recommendations with current and future activities and, a listing of past activities and current initiatives.

Response to Delegate recommendations

The following assessment and action plan are proposed to address the substance and urgency of items in the recommendations. Recommendations are grouped according to priority or similarity.

Operational

13. Working with libraries regarding literature on hand and needs in underserved districts
14. In underserved districts, work to contact local judges, district attorneys and, probation and parole officers.
15. In underserved districts, work to contact medical boards at local hospitals concerning a CPC presentation.
3. Address all referrals from the CPC Coordinator at GSO promptly.

Action:

Recommendation 2. Districts not associated with a Central Office or Intergroup will have a subcommittee member as a primary contact for CPC related activities.

Recommendations 2, 13, 14, 15 – Noreen is developing letters, one for one to Area 59 DCM's and one to the Professional Community. She is using templates from the CPC Workbook and other AA literature. The committee decided to have Noreen continue to spearhead this effort.

Once approved by subcommittee members, these resources will be made available to DCMs of underserved districts. It is critical to have the active participation of the DCM of an underserved district for this approach to be effective. Noreen is also researching resources available on other Area websites so as not to duplicate efforts.

Recommendation 3 – the subcommittee chairperson is the primary contact for requests from GSO and will inform subcommittee members of each request to see who is interested and available to fulfill the commitment. It is acknowledged that a team of subcommittee members may be needed to fulfill some requests.
