Delegate Recommendations addressed

Event activities – Supported an exhibit booth at the Annual Conference of the Association of Recovery Schools Drexel University, Philadelphia, PA from June 23 – 25, 2015.

Requests

1. District 36 newly formed CPC/PI Committee is primarily focused on young people. They have requested support in the form of CPC focused literature to work with their local organizations. Additionally, this group has an outreach program to Rehabilitation Centers. Bob B., DCM District 36 has been notified.

There was a considerable amount of literature from the convention exhibit at Drexel University that was not distributed. The subcommittee gave the requesting CPC/PI local committee, which is located in District 36, Harrisburg a majority of the literature we had on hand.

2. Contacted by Ira, from a young person's meeting at Villanova University concerning a Facility Use Agreement that the University wants the group to sign. The group thinks that a provision in the contract regarding minors is not in the best interest of the A.A. group meeting there. The group has requested a meeting with the

University officials and is awaiting a meeting time. The Chair of the CPC Subcommittee will attend this meeting with the group representatives.

3. May 2015, the subcommittee received a request from GSR regarding a request from an individual in Dillsburg PA offering church meeting Space for an A.A. meeting. Bob B, DCM 36 contacted the local church and informed the individual that there was a local meeting close to the church. There may be opportunities to use the space for other AA Activities. The chair will close the request with GSO.

Upcoming events

1. District 21 will be holding a workshop on October 3, 2015 with the theme, "The History of AA in the Philadelphia Area." They have asked for support.
2. District 35 has scheduled a speaker event for Saturday, October 24, 2015 at 11 AM near Chambersburg, PA to focus on the 3 Legacies of Unity, Recovery, and Service. They have requested CPC presence at this event.
