II. Significant Developments

III. Update of progress on Delegate's recommendations

Recommendations # 4, 6, 7, 9, 10, 11, 16, 17, 19, 20, 21, 22 & 23: The committee was in agreement and recommends that we proceed with them.

Recommendations # 1 & 2 regarding the T/F S/N workbooks: These issues were not discussed because the workbooks had not come in at that time. They have subsequently been received. Upon dispersal, we will cover these points and report back.

Recommendation #3: The committee recommends keeping the displays separate. Regarding point 6, we have already assigned each member on the committee a geographical area.

Recommendation #8 (workshops with other area subcommittees): The committee wants to consider and discuss further.

Recommendation #12: The committee is not in agreement primarily around cost.

Recommendations #13, 14, 15: The committee would like to combine the three different facilities into one function.

Recommendation #18: Currently under further review.
