Response to Delegate Recommendations

Operational

Recommendations

1. Become familiar with the Cooperation with the Professional Community Kit & Workbook, the Cooperation with the Professional Community Guidelines and other selected AA literature that the subcommittee deems appropriate.
6. Update CPC displays as needed.

2. Explore ways in which you can assist Districts—particularly those without Intergroups/Central Offices—in their CPC activities.
3. Address all referrals from the CPC Coordinator at GSO promptly.
5. Assign subcommittee members to Districts to help cover the responsibility for bringing CPC displays and presentations to District meetings and workshops to minimize travel demands.
7. Provide a CPC display at all Area events, including our annual Convention/Assembly, District workshops (if invited) and combined Area/Intergroup, YPAA functions such as Share-A-Days. Each subcommittee member should have their own display and literature to distribute at such events.

Action

2. Members of the subcommittee have been notified again by the most recent past chair of the Lebanon Area Intergroup Association that they remain defunct due to lack of participation therefore responsibility for maintaining CPC activities will be met by subcommittee member Larry L (DCM 65).

3. Any requests from the CPC Coordinator at GSO will be treated as top priority and to the best of our ability will be handled expeditiously.
5. To date assignments for CPC displays have been handled on an *ad hoc* basis. Permanent assignments will be made at the subcommittee in March.
7. To date, CPC displays were provided for the DCM Orientation/Mini Assembly Planning meeting in Bristol, PA on Jan 22, 2017, and at the Combined Districts 32, 38, 44, and 56 GSR Orientation Workshop in Kennett, Square, PA on February 11, 2017. We will provide a display for the Share A Day event on February 19, 2017 at the University of the Sciences in Philadelphia, PA and provide a formal presentation as well. Of course, as always, we will have a presence at the quarterly Area 59 Meeting.
