Response to Delegate Recommendations

Operational

Recommendations

1. Address all referrals from the CPC Coordinator at GSO promptly. Share the results of your efforts with the Coordinator for their records and with the Area Committee.

Action

1. Jeff Wine, the current GSO CPC Coordinator requested that our Area CPC Committee man a booth at the annual NASPA Convention. The event is being held at the Philadelphia Convention Center from March 3 -7. This is their 100th annual convention and an attendance of 7,500 is anticipated. This organization is the National Association of Student Affairs Administrators (in higher education) and their theme this years is substance abuse and alcoholism. This is a fantastic opportunity for outreach to the very folks that advise and counsel our young folks.

High Priority

Recommendations

5. Assign subcommittee members to Districts to help cover the responsibility for bringing CPC displays and presentations to District meetings and workshops to minimize travel demands.
7. Provide a CPC display at all Area events, including our annual Convention/Assembly, District workshops (if invited) and combined Area/Intergroup, YPAA functions such as Share-A-Days. Each subcommittee member should have their own display and literature to distribute at such events.
15. Select a committee representative for the Area day planning committee for the second half of the panel.

5. Members continue to be assigned to workshops on an ad hoc basis based on availability.

6. This quarter CPC displays were provided for several workshops as well as for the EPGSA-SEPIA Share A Day event. There were several cases however where we were unable to provide coverage due to scheduling conflicts. Of course, as always, we will have a presence at the quarterly Area 59 Meetings.
15. Jon H. has agreed to assume this important role and has already participated in the first planning meeting
