CPC Subcommittee Report Q2 2019

Summary of Subcommittee Activities:

- Banner stands were designed and obtained for subcommittee members to bring a more professional look to the presentation of information.
- Our pilot program of developing a method for bringing information into hospitals is ongoing. Overall the response has been positive in that the need for literature is obvious. However, as is perhaps expected, hospital staff have other priorities so continuous follow-up is necessary to make it happen.
 - We have successfully placed literature in the Access Center at Crozer-Chester Medical Center. An acrylic rack with space for six pamphlets was provided along with the following list of literature:
 - A Newcomer Asks (P-24)
 - This is A.A. (P-1)
 - Is A.A. for You? (P-3)
 - The A.A. Member – Medications and Other Drugs (P-11)
 - A.A. at a Glance (F-1)
 - Problems Other Than Alcohol (Excerpts) (F-8)
 - District 55 trifold meeting listTwo additional public information literature displays each with 100 A.A. at a Glance (M-46) were provided to give flexibility to the staff to provide information at other locations within the facility. District 55 covered the cost of the literature display.
 - Other hospitals that are in process:
 - Lankenau Medical Center
 - Bryn Mawr Hospital
 - Paoli Hospital
 - Riddle Hospital – for this we are considering whether to be listed as a vendor to allow greater flexibility to interact within the hospital
- We fielded two requests from the CPC desk at GSO from persons seeking information about starting new groups within the region.
- Made a connection with the Providence Center in Philadelphia. This community group operates in the Kensington area of Philadelphia and receives some that have problems with alcohol thus the need for A.A. literature. Ultimately this was passed to SEPIA.
- We are continuing to review delegate recommendations as a guide of committee activities
