The Ad Hoc Literature subcommittee is chartered to educate members of Area 59 about the importance of our literature in carrying the message. This includes the publication of our Area 59 service newsletter "We". As a committee we meet monthly on a digital platform. We designated a subcommittee member for each district to cover the responsibility of attending district workshops and events upon request. At each event, members display a literature rack.
