

Finance Subcommittee Report E.P.G.S.A. Area 59 Panel 73 June 11, 2023 Area Quarterly Meeting, Q3 Milesburg, PA

The Finance Subcommittee continues to hold virtual meetings and has kept in contact via email and phone between meetings.

The Subcommittee has 7th Tradition packets available and encourages the use of the virtual 7th Tradition packets and virtual contributions whenever possible.

The Subcommittee discussed the feasibility of migrating to Quickbooks Online for Area 59 Finances via TechSoup. TechSoup offers a 1-year subscription for up to 5 users for \$75, to be renewed annually. The Subcommittee reached the conclusion to stick with the current desktop version of Quickbooks and backup the information on a Google Drive in case of a computer crash. Currently, the only backup is on the Treasurer's laptop.

There is a one-year delay for the Form 1099-K tax reporting rule, requiring payment services (Venmo, PayPal, etc.) to issue the form for business transfers of more than \$600. This has been done to provide additional guidance on the issue.

The Subcommittee is in the process of obtaining two new displays for committee members to bring two various events.
