AA's Fellowship Connection Database

Area 59 Eastern Pennsylvania has a robust service structure comprising 48 districts. We have 1,627 active, registered groups; 23 of which are virtual. One of my main responsibilities is to keep the information in Fellowship Connection as current as possible. Fellowship Connection is the database that our General Service Office uses to track all registered groups and their representatives. The information in this database is only as good as what we put into it. So please help by submitting any changes through the "Group Change Form" on our website. DCMs are granted read-only access to this database so that you may view and download reports at any time. If you would like to access this database and have been unable to do so, please let me know. I am always happy to send you reports about your district at any time.

When should I submit a change to Area 59?

- Starting a new group
- Registering an existing group
- Changing a group's name, meeting location, format (in-person or virtual), or district
- There is a new GSR, Alternate GSR, or Mail Contact
- A group becomes inactive, or an inactive group becomes active again

Please note: A personal email address owned by the individual is required, and not a rotating position email address. A mailing address is also required to enter a new contact. The database now requires me to enter a service position end date. This date defaults to two years, and I add an extra year so there is some cushion. At the service end date, that person drops from the group and a new service end date or new contact is required to keep the group from obtaining an "unknown" status. If the contact does not use email at all, they can still be recorded, but I must contact Member Services and ask them to make the change.

What if a group needs to make a change on the Meeting Guide App?

- Submit the change to your local intergroup, if your district is served by one. Area 59 contains 10 intergroups! If the group is not served by an intergroup, submit the change to the district. The meeting lists maintained by intergroups and districts are what feed into the Meeting Guide App, and also to the meeting list on the Area 59 website.

Young People in Alcoholics Anonymous & District 68 (Spanish-speaking groups)

I serve as your Area 59 Officer Liaison to Young People in AA (YPAA) and to District 68, our Spanish linguistic district. We are planning a Share-A-Day for YPAA, District 68, and Area 59 on Saturday, October 7th. Please save the date. I believe I have contacted all of the active Young People's committees to get it on their radar. If your District has a Young People's meeting, please let me know so that I can personally invite them to participate. Various YPAA committees throughout the state submit bids for the opportunity to host. This year it will be hosted by Bucks County and will be held July 14-16 in Langhorne, PA. Spanish interpretation will be available at the conference. Weekend registration is \$25. The block of discounted hotel rooms is completely sold out, but you can get on a waiting list and they are trying to add an overflow hotel. Check the Area 59 calendar frequently as new events are added all the time.
