- We have continued to reach out to numerous treatment facilities to see how or if we can extend the hand of AA. Some have been very receptive and some not so much.
- One of our members in Northeast PA is working closely with a treatment liaison to bring more meetings into facilities.
- One member of our committee is continuing to work closely with BTG coordinator to create a new pamphlet that focuses on treatment. This will complement the existing corrections pamphlet.
- Our chairperson has attended all BTG meetings so far and our committee is continuing to promote and offer support to BTG.
- Caron treatment facility has placed the link to BTG on each patient Chromebook and are impressed with results of the program. Patients are continuing to sign up and Caron is considering promoting BTG company wide.
- We have been telling our districts the importance of BTG and people are signing up. Accessibility needs of potential new AAs from BTG are also being considered.
- Some of our committee members live in districts without intergroups and are more involved in facilities within those districts. Members of our committee have continued to visit and offer support to intergroups throughout Area 59.
