I received an email from G.S.O. about an inmate at S.C.I. Rockview writing to them wanting books. G.S.O. informed me that they sent some books, but we should handle this as an Area. I contacted Alex from District 43, and he informed me their Correction Committee will take care of it.

I was contacted by S.C.I. Camp Hill about Pre-release information. I spoke to Jim L. and he said that they don't want to release their contacts information, and neither do we. So we decided to go to Camp Hill and talk to the Clinical Director to come up with a solution.

Steve I. from the Harrisburg Intergroup said the person who brings meetings to S.C.I. Camp Hill needs to know how to get the literature into the Institutions Library, or into the hands of the inmate. This is something else I am going to bring up with the Clinical Director of S.C.I. Camp Hill.

We will meet prior to this Quarterly Meeting to discuss what goals we have for the upcoming year and when our next subcommittee meeting will be.
