The Honorable Robert Repard is a member of the Special Court Judges' Association of Pennsylvania, currently serving as director for District 3, as well as sitting on several community boards. He currently instructs Defensive Tactics and Court Facility Security for the Sheriff and Deputy Sheriffs Education and Training Program at Penn State University's Justice and Safety Institute. He served 26 years as a Probation Officer with the Tioga County Probation Department before retiring from supervisor in 2011. During his time as a probation officer, he helped develop and implement court facility security measures and office safety protocols, and served as a two term Commissioner to the County Probation and Parole Officers Firearm Education and Training Commission. Judge Repard was named "Outstanding Law Enforcement Officer" by Mansfield Area Jaycees in 1989 and was awarded with the Pennsylvania Juvenile Court Judges Commission Award for outstanding service to the Pennsylvania Juvenile Justice System in 1994.
