- Worldly AI Translation - we unanimously passed a motion to purchase a 10 hr subscription to Wordly for use at Area 59 events. The total cost was \$1,450 which included a on time \$500 on boarding, set-up, and training charge (buying a larger amount of hours would bring a discount).
  - We received feedback from the tech servants who have since registered the account for Area 59 and hold access to all of the account information.
  - On February 12, we attended an On Boarding and Training session and the account is now ready for use.
  - We are updating the glossary for increased accuracy.
